"Many rural and farm communities - the very places where crops are grown to feed the world - face hunger. It seems impossible, but in lands of plenty, hunger pains can be the sharpest."

- Rural communities make up 63% of counties in the United States
- Of the counties with the highest rates of food insecurity, 78% of them are rural.
- 84% of the counties with the highest percentage of children at risk for food insecurity are rural.

Thank you, Deb, for your devotion and service to your community. May you be blessed for your generosity of love for the pantry.

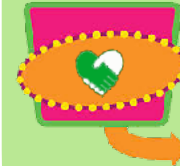
