For the duration of the recommended social isolation families are being given pre-packed boxes at the entrance door. These boxes are filled in proportion to family size. Some of the items included are canned products, boxed dinners, cereals, pancake mix, several frozen meat items, eggs, milk (when available), as well as a variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, and some coveted paper products!

If you or someone you know could use a little extra help putting food on the table during these challenging times, Helping Hands of Roseville is here to serve.

Hours remain Mondays 9 a.m. - Noon, and Thursdays, 3-6 p.m.
